SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Freshman Scholarships

ALUMNAE SCHOLARSHIP

This award is given to the daughter or granddaughter of an alumna of St. Ursula Academy who demonstrates financial need. The student must promise to contribute 20 hours of service to SUA her freshman year. The scholarship may be renewed if the student maintains a satisfactory GPA and exhibits the ideals of an SUA student. The number of students selected and the amount of the award will vary.

BUILDING FUTURES SCHOLARSHIP

This four-year renewable award is available to incoming students who demonstrate financial need. The scholarship may be renewed if the student exhibits a genuine love of the school and maintains grades that reflect a consistent effort. The number of students selected and the amount of the award will vary.

GLADIEUX FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is designated for an incoming freshman whose family demonstrates serious financial need. It may be renewed for each of the remaining three years if the student maintains a minimum 3.0 GPA. The amount of the award will vary.

LEADERSHIP CHALLENGE SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was created for students who are Catholic or who have attended a Catholic grade school, who have been recommended by their grade school principal or teacher as having the potential to succeed academically at SUA, who demonstrate financial need and who have promised to participate in the work-study program. The scholarship is renewable for three additional years to students who continue to qualify. The number of students selected and the amount of the award will vary.

LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP

This award is given to daughters of alumnae who demonstrate financial need. It may be renewed each of the remaining three years if the student maintains a minimum GPA of 2.0. The amount of the award will vary.

SR. KATHLEEN PADDEN SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was established in honor of Sr. Kathleen, who served as SUA president from 1989-2001. Incoming freshmen must demonstrate financial need. The scholarship may be renewed in subsequent years if the student continues to need assistance and demonstrates a genuine love of the school. The number of students selected and the amount of the award will vary.

ST. ANGELA MERICI LEADERSHIP AWARD

Named for the foundress of the Ursuline order, who dedicated her service to improve the lives of others, this four-year renewable scholarship is awarded to 10 incoming freshmen who have graduated from a Catholic elementary school and who demonstrate leadership abilities. Each recipient will receive a \$1,000 award.

ST. GERARD SCHOLARSHIP

This four-year renewable scholarship is available to selected students from Queen of Apostles, Rosary Cathedral, St. Charles Borromeo and St. Elizabeth Seton elementary schools. The award is based on placement test scores, financial need and involvement in extracurricular activities. The number of students selected and the amount of the award will vary.

URSULINE COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP

This four-year renewable scholarship, based on the applicant's school performance, is available to students from St. Charles, St. Elizabeth Seton, Queen of Apostles, Rosary Cathedral and St. Thomas Aquinas elementary schools. One student will be selected for an award of \$2,500.

ST. URSULA ACADEMY ACADEMIC AWARDS

A four-year scholarship of \$3,000 annually is offered to incoming freshmen who score in the 98th and 99th percentile on the SUA Placement Test. No application is required.

A two-year scholarship in varied amounts is offered to those who score in the 90th to 97th percentile on the SUA Placement Test. No application is required.
