

RESOURCES TO LEARN



PROGRAMS

Drop-in tutoring

Personal attention is given to students who desire a re-explanation of class material.

Java with Johnson

Licensed educators are available before the school day begins (7-8 a.m.) to offer help with homework and test preparation.

Focus

Students who are identified with ongoing academic challenges are paired with TLC educators and meet twice weekly (or more) for guidance and direct content support.

Academic Success Coaching

Staff members encourage a growth mindset and identify ways for students to implement it.

Targeted Intervention

TLC educators work with counselors, teachers, parents, and students to formulate intervention plans for students experiencing a temporary lack of success.

Writing Consults

Students meet with TLC educators by appointment for writing consults, developing skills in the areas of essay structure and style.

State Test Support

TLC educators teach strategies for maximizing performance on state-required tests.

ACT/SAT Preparation

TLC educators offer workshops for students preparing to take the ACT and SAT college entrance exams.

Exam Review

Intense and timely reviews are offered during which students can work with TLC educators to prepare for exams.

Professional educators, licensed in core content areas, provide personal assistance in academic content. The staff of The Learning Commons collaborate with teaching faculty and counselors concerning plans for students experiencing academic challenges.
