- Recruits and trains all student retreat leaders
- Recruits and moderates Campus Ministry Core Team
- Engages student participation in peer and prayer ministry
- Collaborates with School Counselors, Campus Minister of Christian Service and Ursuline Spirit, and Theology Departments in meeting the spiritual needs of the students
- Attends and participate in all Theology department meetings

- Designs all retreats based on the needs of faculty and staff

- Acts as sacristan, securing hosts, chapel, and altar preparation, sacred linens, etc.

- Coordinates student leadership and participation in all liturgical experiences
- Upholds the dignity and sanctity of the St. Angela Merici Chapel as well as organization and cleanliness of the sacristy
- Recruits, educates, and prepares Juniors and Seniors to be Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion
- Creates and designs prayer services
