Dear SUA Families:

Today the Toledo-Lucas County Health Department recommended that all schools begin the year remotely until October 1, 2020, considering the rise in COVID-19 positive cases over the last month. After much discussion and with the support of our Board of Trustees, SUA will proceed with our existing Safe Return-to-School Plan that provides parents the option to select On-Campus Learning or Home Learning. Due to our size, we are able to accommodate all the recommended safety protocols that include six-foot social distancing, face masks for all, temperature scanners, daily sanitation and hygiene requirements, a flexible attendance policy, and staggered school start times.

We understand and recognize that you may be feeling many emotions as information changes regarding the COVID-19 pandemic. We want to reiterate that families have the option to select Home Learning at any time. We are here for you and your daughters.

As previously shared, we will begin on August 13 – 18 with our Return-to-School Orientations for grade-level classes. It is our hope to welcome everyone back to campus on Wednesday, August 19; however, we will be closely monitoring this situation. Any adjustments with regard to Athletics have, yet to be determined.

Return-to-School Class Orientations

To safely bring the girls back to campus and educate them in safety protocols and expectations, we will open the school year with each grade level attending a Return-to-School Orientation on the following dates:

Friday, August 14 Freshman Orientation

Tuesday, August 18 Junior/Senior Orientation
