Dear SUA Families,

Today the Toledo-Lucas County Health Department (TLCHD) issued an order that states that schools (grades 7-12) must transition to remote learning until Monday, January 11, 2021. For our SUA Community this means that we will extend our Home Learning Mandate for All (grades 6-12) with a return to On Campus, In-Person Learning on Monday, January 11.

Please note the following date changes in red:

November 25 – 27 Thanksgiving Break (No Change)

November 30 Teacher Workday to Transition into Home Learning (No School/No Classes)

December 1 – December 18 Home Learning Mandate for All

December 19 – January 5 Christmas Break

January 6 – 8 Home Learning Mandate for All

January 11 On-Campus/In-Person Learning Resumes

Given that this order from the TLCHD just passed this morning, we still have some planning to do. The order goes into effect on December 4, which allows SUA to prepare for the following:

- Home Learning Mandate for All extends into the new semester. We will set up drop off and pick up dates and times for resources such as textbooks, novels, art supplies, etc.
- The order also mentions school campuses being closed to extracurriculars and sports. Once we have more information, we will communicate plans to the respective teams and impacted extracurricular programs such as the Musical.

As always, we will continue to share with you any changes as they occur.

Although we are heartbroken that we will not be together in person during Advent as we anticipate the birth our Lord, please know that we are grateful for you as we continue on this winding journey during COVID-19.
