Dear Parents,

We are pleased to announce an opportunity for St. Ursula Academy students (16 and over), parents, and siblings (16 and over) to receive a Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine on Friday, April 16 from 3:00-6:00 p.m. and Friday, May 7 from 3:00-6:00 p.m. at Ottawa Hills High School (Kadens Family Fitness Center). Given all the year-end activities and celebrations, we encourage you to make an appointment. Getting vaccinated will help us all get back to the activities we love more quickly.

The Pfizer vaccine, which is highly effective at preventing severe illness from COVID-19, is only authorized for those 16 years old and above. All shots will be administered by appointment only, and registration is required.

If a parent will not be present for the appointment, you must complete the attached Consent Form for your daughter to receive the vaccine. All forms must be submitted to the SUA's Main Office by Thursday at 12:30 p.m. If a parent will be present, a Consent Form is not required.

An access code will be sent to you (once we receive it from the Toledo-Lucas County Health Department) and you will use this code to register for your vaccine appointment.

If you are unable to register for the Pfizer vaccine for April 16/May 7, we encourage you to seek out additional opportunities offered by the Toledo-Lucas County Health Department or other vaccine providers. Given the timing with the end of the school year, this will be the only opportunity offered through St. Ursula Academy.

Thank you for your commitment to the health of our community. We know that this is a very busy time and we appreciate your willingness to seize this opportunity to be vaccinated and help us all enjoy more gatherings and in-person activities in the months ahead.

We will send you the access code as soon as we receive it but for now, please save the date. Feel free to reach out with any questions.
