





Consider each job you take as a stepping stone to what you want next. Always be thinking multiple steps ahead. Play the long game.


Internships & Work Experience

Internships and work experience that can apply (or help you figure out!) what you want to do will help you on your journey to finding a career you are passionate about!

- There are a lot of opportunities on-campus or near school that can help you land that prestigious internship.
 - Find them by: 1) Spending time at your Campus Career Center 2) Talk to your professors and TAs 3) Actually go to Office Hours 4) Googling a LOT & Keep Asking 5) Be friendly to EVERYONE who works at your school 6) Read the campus paper *often* 7) Find a gap and offer to fill it.
- @ Syracuse I did these things *on campus* starting my freshman year before a formal internship!
 - Worked in Undergraduate Research after my professor brought it up to me in office hours (Paid)
 - Worked @ Carrier Dome for a professor who offered me a permanent job after a referral from another teacher (Paid)
 - Volunteered to write for the school paper when I noticed they needed help with Tech Coverage
 - Leadership position in my sorority
- → helped me land interview for coveted (paid) internships my Sophomore and Junior years.
- Ied me to have a job offer in hand the Fall of my Senior Year.

Evaluate opportunities by asking yourself: Does this help teach me a skill that would help me in the future? Does this give me an edge or a competitive advantage? Will i walk away having learned something that I can explain to someone in an interview?

PMs:


- Come from a variety of backgrounds (engineering, design, business, data science, design)

Be the first to hear about new jobs that match what you want




