To safely bring the girls back to school and educate them in safety protocols and expectations, we will open the school year with each grade level attending a Return-to-School Orientation/School Picture Day from 9:00 a.m.– 3:00 p.m. on the following dates:

SCHOOL HANDBOOK CHANGE FOR 2020-2021: LATIN HONORS AS IT RELATES TO REDUCED CREDIT HOURS DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

For the past three years, SUA has been planning to implement Latin Honors in place of SUA's valedictorian/salutatorian recognition beginning the 2020-2021 academic year. This recognition has been designed around students earning 31.75 credit hours. SUA is adjusting the credit hour requirement because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Students will be recognized for their academic achievement based on both GPA and academic integrity. Students with academic integrity infractions will not be recognized regardless of GPA. Students earning Summa Cum Laude Latin Honors must have attended SUA all eight (8) semesters of high school. Latin Honors are determined by final cumulative GPA with a minimum credit requirement as listed below:

- Classes of 2021 and 2022
 - 29.75 adjusted minimum graduation credit requirement because of fewer credits earned in 2020-2021
- Classes of 2023 and 2024
 - 30.75 adjusted minimum graduation credit requirement because of fewer credits earned in 2020-2021

Summa Cum Laude: Highest Praise	4.4 and above	
Magna Cum Laude: High Praise	4.2 - 4.399	
Cum Laude: Praise	4.0 – 4.199	

Students earning respective GPA's will still qualify for all three levels of Latin Honors regardless of

earning fewer credits during the 2020-2021 academic year. We remain committed to academic excellence while responding to student needs during the COVID-19 pandemic. If your daughter is interested in hearing more about the option to have a Quiet Study, please contact her counselor.
